Paper Boat Instructions

Cut out the boat and mast support templates.

Trace them onto heavy paper (like cardstock) or light cardboard (like a cereal box).

Mark the score lines and use the back of an exacto knife, table knife, (or similar) to score them.

Fold the mast support into a triangle and glue (use a paper clip or clothespin to clamp it). Mark the top of the mast support.

Fold the boat gently at the score lines.

Apply glue to the bow and press the sides together (use a paper clip or clothespin to clamp it - alternatively you can stitch them together).

Bend up tab A and apply glue to the top. Bend up tab B - covering the top of tab A and matching the top edges. Apply glue and bend up tab C covering the top of tab B and matching the top edges. Clamp and let dry.

Poke a small hole in the flat top of the mast support triangle and insert the skewer. Apply glue inside the triangle where the mast inserts and let dry.

Cut out a sail and flag from paper. Poke the two small holes on the sail and insert the mast through the holes.

Glue a loop of string to the top of the skewer. Fold the flag in half and glue it over the top of the mast.

Glue the mast support into the boat.
